

A Roar of Greenery: Benholm Group's Green Touch at Edinburgh Zoo

In addition, robust Rubber Plants were set in natural concrete planters and filled with Scottish stone cobbles, and Snake Plants were placed in barrier planters to add a modern touch to the traditional setting; whilst defining spaces within the hospitality areas and contributing to a cleaner, fresher indoor atmosphere.
